PRL 114: Wills, Trusts and Estates Descriptions

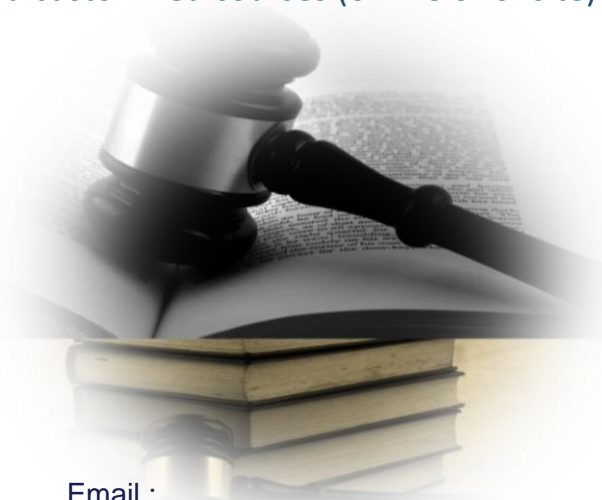
